Linking Autumn Friends: Use plastic linking chains to put the numbers together from 0 and continue on.



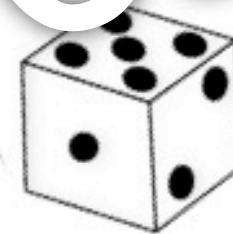
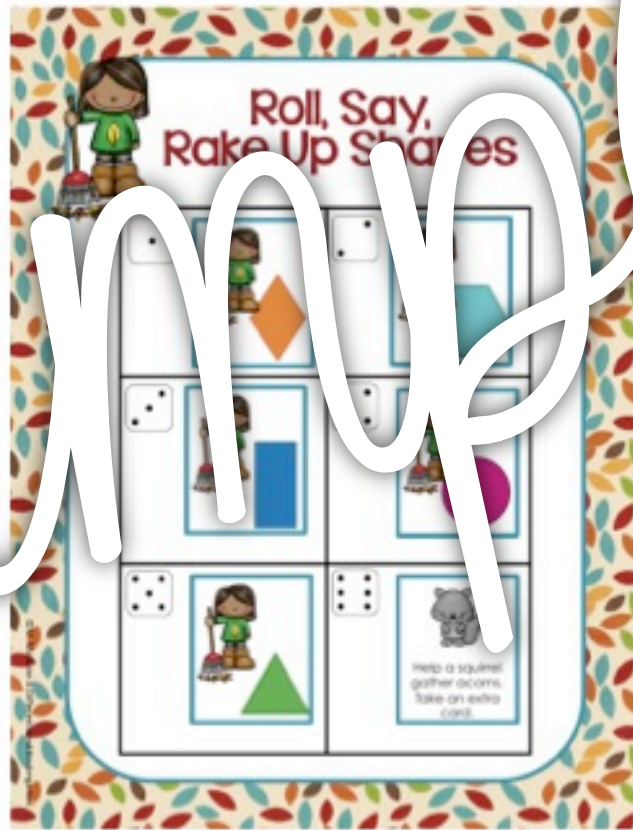
Count and Color Autumn Fun: Count the objects on the mat and record your answer.

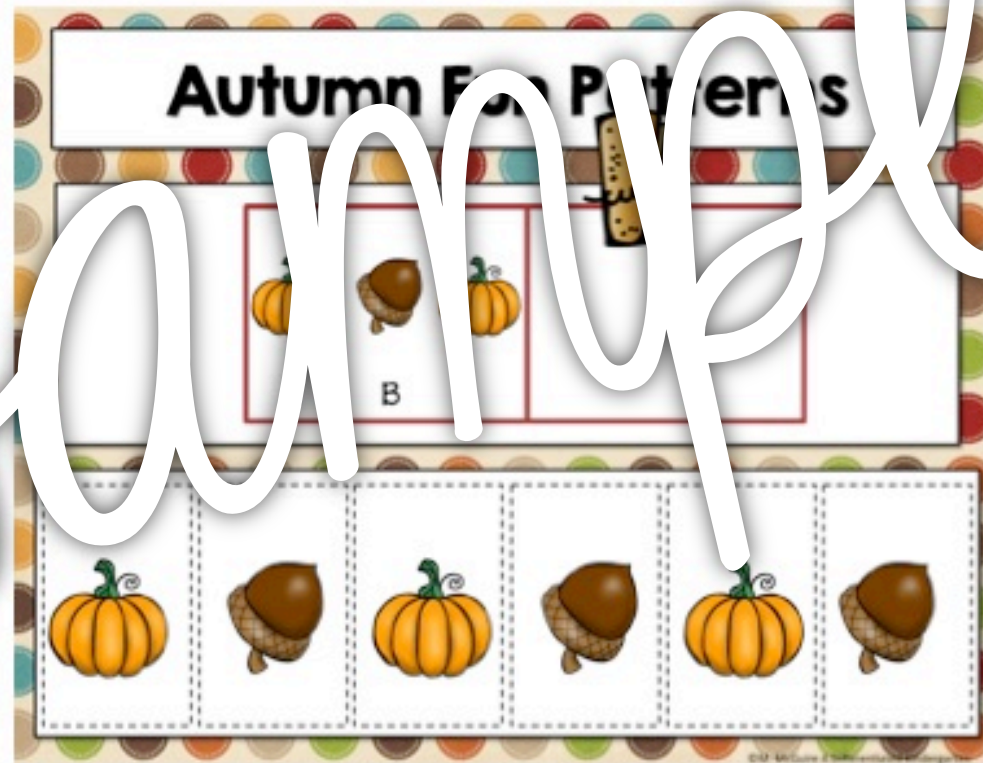
Roll, Say Rake Up Shapes: Roll the dice and say the shape that is in that numbered box. If you get it correct you get to keep it.
