

Using this packet to differentiate




Here is an example using blends. There are three different spinners available for blends in this packet. This will allow for some extension of activities and ample opportunity to differentiate. For instance, one spinner has just a picture, one a picture with the word, and one has just the blend. Likewise, the recording sheets are differentiated as well. You will find one recording sheet that has just pictures, one with pictures and words and one with just words. This is how an activity from this spinner packet might look if it were in your planning book:








Spin A Rime: Spin the spinner to select a rime. Place the rime after an onset letter. Color the bird red if it makes a real word. If it makes a nonsense word, color the bird blue.
