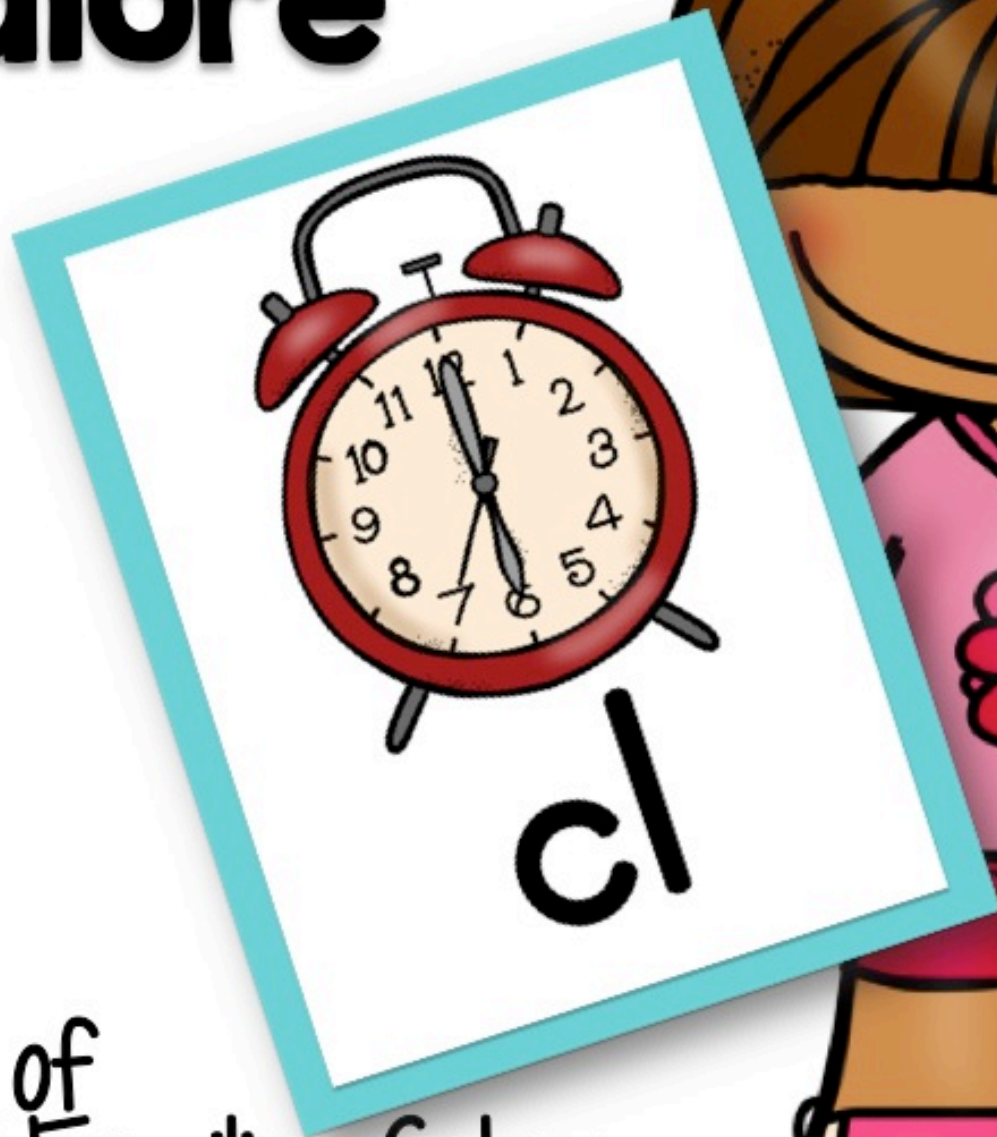

There are many words from which you can choose from in this packet to add to your word wall. You definitely do not need to use all of them. Use only the ones that are appropriate for your class. There are two options for posters. You can choose to have a full size word blend poster and use the long thin word cards that follow and mount them with painters tape like did with these word family posters below.



Or you can choose to use the half page size with the smaller word cards and place them in a pocket chart for the week you are using them.

Say It-Make It-Write It Read-It-Check-It

Each blend unit includes a set of self-correcting cards for that blend. There are two different mats to choose from depending on the readiness of your students. Students use the self-correcting cards to make this station independent. You can use a variety of materials to extend this station. The 'Make It' section can use magnetic letters, wikki sticks, playdoh and letter stamps or beads. Be creative with your materials to keep this station interesting. As you introduce more and more blends, this station will grow with it and provide tons of word work practice.

There is also a Read-It-Check-It option for students who need practice reading the blend and checking to see if they read the correct word.

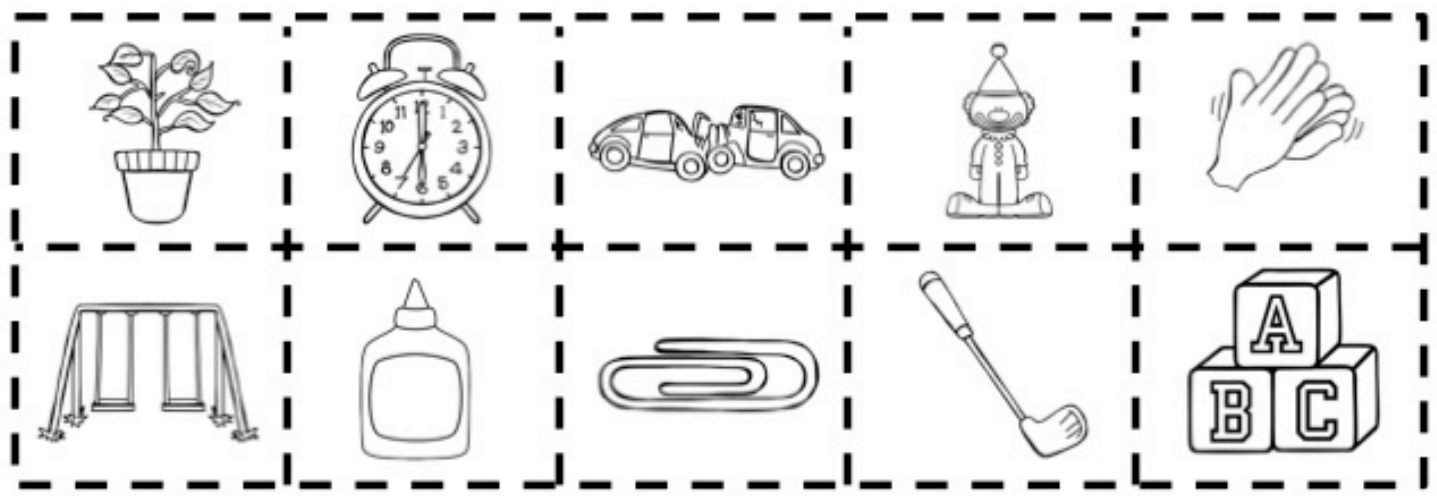
Thumbs Up for CL
