You Can't Hide: This is a game that you can play as your students are introduced to more and more digraphs. Add as many digraph word cards as your students are ready for in a helmet basket or bucket, along with the special playing cards. Students take turns pulling cards and reading the words aloud. If they say the word correctly, they keep the card. If not, the card goes back in the bucket and it goes to the next player. A "You are a thief" card means you get to "steal" a card from each person playing. A "trash" card means you lose a turn. A "Wish" card means you get to go again. A "Finish" card means play stops, and count cards to see who wins.

Roll-Say-Keep: Use the small word cards and add the cards from above to make this a bit more interesting. Use this game when you have introduced several word families and would like to give your students more practice. Place of cards face down in a pile and the roll out one card to every position on the mat. Students roll the dice and say the word on that number's spot. If the student gets it correct, they will keep the card.
