Small Playing Cards

Memory Match: These playing cards are used for memory. Use to flip in a different smaller card by the face from target, but you can really do whatever you want. The cards are the traditional memory with illustrations matching the word with the correct corresponding picture.

Sorting: Here are also the cards you can use for sorting word families since you have introduced more than one family. Check that the matching sides of the card is the word! You can use a pocket chart or use a hula-hoop and for container and then have the cards go into the container. Or you can use a card reading game like I Spy. That's a card game that you can use as a memory for word families and introduction, but readable or un-readable you can find that is helpful or fun and use it after the correct word family is in the correct word family container. This is a creative activity in my class. Here is a recording sheet if you would like.
